SUBJECT: Delegation of Powers to the Secretaries of the Military Departments to Make Determinations Under the Social Security Act and Federal Insurance Contributions Act

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Directive is to reissue reference (c) with the necessary changes required by references (a) and (b).

2. CANCELLATION

Reference (c) is hereby canceled.

3. AUTHORIZATION

Pursuant to authority contained in the National Security Act of 1947 (61 Stat. 500), as amended (5 U.S.C. 171a(f)), the Secretaries of the Army, the Navy and the Air Force are hereby designated to exercise the powers, functions and duties conferred upon the Secretary of Defense in references (a) and (b), pertaining to members of the Uniformed Services and civilian employees within the cognizance of their respective Departments.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Directive is effective as of January 1, 1957.
